1 Product Discontinuation Notification (PDN)

This is to advise you that in compliance with Atlona's product discontinuation procedures, we are announcing the discontinuation of the following products:

Notification Date: **July 14, 2025**

Discontinuation Date: **August 4, 2025**

The above product(s) will be available for purchase while supplies last. Any products purchased after the discontinuation date will be subject to a one (1) year warranty as per Atlona's Warranty Policy. Atlona will continue to support the above product(s) pursuant to its warranty terms.

2 End Of Service (EOS)

Atlona will support products in accordance with their specific warranty durations, including any extended warranties.

The EOS date for this product will be **August 4, 2026**. After the EOS date for a product, Atlona will discontinue field service and customer support for that product. Testing and validation will also cease. Therefore, any continued use of equipment after its designated EOS date is at the sole risk of the user.

3 Alternative Solutions

AT-HDR-SW-52 – The HDR-SW-52 is a 5-input x 2-output HDMI video matrix switcher. It supports similar resolutions to the OME-SW32. The HDR-SW-52 has 5 HDMI inputs. A USB-C to HDMI adapter will be required if a USB-C connection is necessary.

AT-OME-MS42 – The OME-MS42 is a 4-input x 2-output video matrix switcher. It has a USB-C, DisplayPort, and two HDMI inputs. The USB-C input can provide video, audio, USB data, and 60W of device charging to a connected laptop.

4 Glossary

Term	Description
Notification Date	This is the date on which customers are given notice of the discontinuation and are guided to purchase spares or units required for any purpose. The product will remain available for purchase while supplies last. Customers are encouraged to engage with their Atlona Sales Representative to discuss product and solution migration options. After the discontinuation is announced, Atlona may choose to stop implementing new features on the product. Bug reports will be reviewed and, if required, fixed until the Discontinuation or EOS date depending on their severity. Quality Assurance testing will continue until the EOS date. Notice of the Discontinuation and EOS dates are provided as part of the PDN.
Discontinuation Date	The Discontinuation Date is the date when the product is considered discontinued. Any products purchased after the Discontinuation Date will be subject to a reduced warranty period, in accordance with Atlona's Warranty Policy. Support agreements and warranty service will be honored as per Atlona's Warranty Policy up to the EOS date.
EOS	EOS (End of Service) signifies the point at which all official support for a product is discontinued, and users who continue to operate these devices do so entirely at their own risk. The EOS date is specifically aligned with the warranty duration of the product at the time of purchase, including any applicable extended warranty periods. The EOS will not be extended beyond the warranty period.
